- 3. Only current KOTESOL Members (membership expiry after October 5 2014) are eligible to cast a ballot. That list was presented prior to the conference, and is augmented half-daily by memberships paid at the conference.
- Policies determining election of candidates are specified in KOTESOL Bylaws (Article VII) and Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (11<sup>th</sup> Edition). Of note, blank ballots shall be treated as abstention (p. 415).
